A. <u>PUBLIC POLICY INSTITUTE OF CALIFORNIA (PPIC) WATER POLICY CENTER SPONSORSHIP (CM#2018.80)</u>

Chair Longville voiced her support of the PPIC Water Policy Center and its contributions, and supported staff's recommendation. Commissioner Whitaker noted PPIC generally does good work on public policy; however, they put forth a single solution for the entire state and it is important to insist on local solutions and argue against the one-size-fits-all approach as there are very different conditions throughout the state. Chair Long encouraged conveying these local solutions directly to PPIC, and she offered to work with the PPIC in contacting Commissioner Whitaker.
