Recommendation to Commission:


- Conduct a Public Hearing to receive comments, and
- Approve the 5-year update of the Sewer System Management Plan

- 5-year update required as part of SWRCB General Waste Discharge Requirements (2006-0003-DWQ)
- Provides system management tools to reduce Sanitary Sewer Overflows
- Standardizes many of the Brine Line system operations
- Establishes training requirements
- Requires approval from SAWPA Commission after a Public Meeting
- Available at SAWPA's web page

- Brine Line Critical Success Factors
 - Minimize disruptions to customers
 - Protect and preserve the useful life of Brine Line assets through strategic maintenance, repair, and capital improvements
 - Conduct proactive capital and O&M planning to improve efficiency and maintain needed capacity in the long and medium terms.
 - Operate the Brine Line to: (1) protect the OCSD treatment plant and the environment from non-compliant dischargers, and (2) eliminate any uncontrolled pipeline releases.




SSO by Category








