## WLAM Final Report – Geoscience

Johnson Yeh gave a PowerPoint presentation to summarize the entire process of organizing, and finalizing, the Waste Load Allocation Model Summary Report. This model assists the Task Force in presenting ideas and solutions for any groundwater management needs that the Santa Ana Watershed has demonstrated. The model was retrospectively run to look at the years 2007-2016. This allowed the model to produce numbers to compare to the actual values seen during the 2007-2016 years. This produced reliability in accuracy of predicting future values of water quality and levels of TDS and TIN for the groundwater management zones. Geoscience described the steps taken, and data results seen, proceeding from the northeastern corner of San Bernardino County down to the southwestern edge in Orange County, displaying calculations, charts and graphs that describe the water quality and changes in the groundwater basins.

With the completion of the Waste Load Allocation Model Summary Report, Geoscience will be presenting the full overview/process to the SAWPA Commission on Tuesday, December 17, 2019.
