Approval of September 23, 2021 Meeting Notes

Draft Basin Plan Amendment Update - KSC/Regional Board Staff

Tess Dunham, of Kahn, Soares, and Conway, LLP, gave a verbal update on the Basin Plan Amendment (BPA) process. The Basin Plan Amendment has been posted to the Regional Water Quality Control Board's (RWQCB) website in preparation for presentation at the December 10, 2021 Board meeting. Any public comments and feedback are due on November 29, 2021.

Workshop 2 – Critical Analysis of SAR SNMP Ambient Water Quality and Alternative Methods to Comply Pt. 1: What Have We Learned in 17 Years of Implementation? – West Yost

Samantha Adams provided a PowerPoint presentation on the Triennial Ambient Water Quality (AWQ) Update that is completed by the Task Force consultants to observe and analyze changes in the surface water and groundwater over time. She thoroughly reviewed some of the areas that need to be strengthened and highlighted the areas that the current program does well.

To close the presentation, Samantha Adams reviewed some thought provoking questions to gain insight and feedback from the stakeholders. The questions focused on data quality, procedural changes that can be maintained over time, and the prioritization of certain procedural changes over others. The next Task Force meeting is hoped to be a more in-depth conversation amongst the Task Force members to gain insight for the planning priorities as they are developed and recommended by West Yost.
