Regional Board staff has requested Task Force support with AB 2108 compliance associated with the process to amend the Santa Ana Basin Plan to update the Lake Elsinore and Canyon Lake TMDLs. This entails the following:

Recommendation: Direct LESJWA staff to support Regional Board staff with AB 2108 compliance associated with the Lake Elsinore and Canyon Lake TMDLs.

 - a. Action Item: LEAMS 2023 TN Offset Credits Funding Allocation
 - The 2023 Lake Elsinore Offset Report, which reports on the number TP and TN offset credits created from the operations of LEAMS, revealed that there were no total nitrogen credits available to license to stakeholders for 2023.
 - Due to the lack of available total nitrogen credits for 2023, LESJWA staff revised the LEAMS nutrient offset credit allocations to be based solely on the need for total phosphorus offset credits. All excess funds resulting from the reallocation of the 2023 nutrient offset credit allocations are being held in the Task Force reserve account.

Recommendation: Direct LESJWA staff to apply excess funds being held in the Task Force reserve account to reduce stakeholder contributions for FY 2024-25 for stakeholders who purchased 2023 LEAMS nutrient offset credits.

- b. Action Item: WSP USA CO for additional monitoring for an amount not to exceed \$7,400.
 - Lake Elsinore chlorophyll-a sample for each remaining 2024 monitoring event.
 - Canyon Lake Additional WQ samples and reporting related to spring 2024 alum application. Recommendation: Direct LESJWA staff to prepare and authorize a Change Order Request for WSP USA for additional water quality monitoring for an amount not to exceed \$7,400.
