- Phase II of the LE&CL TMDL Implementation Plan requires the Task Force to review and re-authorize existing in-lake nutrient management projects for Canyon Lake and/or approve new in-lake projects within one year of the adoption of the revised TMDLs.
- In response, GEI Consultants has submitted a proposal presenting a phased approach to implement Task 4 of the updated Phase 2 Implementation Plan. The purpose of this task is to:
- Evaluate the effectiveness and nutrient offsets provided by the existing alum addition project in Canyon Lake.
 - Assess the feasibility of other potential in-lake projects aimed at nutrient reduction.
- The initial Phase 1 Scope (Task 2) focuses on implementing near-term modifications to the existing Canyon Lake Alum Addition Program. These activities fall under Task 2 of the GEI Proposal and are scheduled to be completed during FY 2025–26, for an amount not to exceed \$26,700.
- The remaining elements of the GEI Proposal (Tasks 3 through 6) comprise the broader scope of work necessary to prepare the Canyon Lake Water Quality Control Report, as required by Task 4 of the Implementation Plan. These tasks are estimated at an additional \$196,300 and will be brought forward for consideration at a future date.
- Recommendation:** Direct LESJWA staff to prepare a Task Order for GEI Consultants authorizing only the Phase 1 near-term modifications to the Canyon Lake Alum Addition Program (Task 2), to be implemented in FY 2025–26 for an amount not to exceed \$26,700.
